Visiting Hours
Surgical Services: No visiting in the OR or PACU.
In ASU: One person is allowed with each patient at a time. Exception: Children & both parents may be present.
Emergency Department: One person is allowed with each patient. Exception: Children & both parents may be present.
Medical Surgery: Third & Fourth Floor: 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. Visitors under the age of 12 need nursing staff permission. There is no limit on the number of visitors unless the patient's condition justifies fewer visitors. If the patient is in isolation, all visitors are asked to first report to the nurse's station.

Pediatrics: Parents are allowed 24 hours a day. All others 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. No visitors under 16 years of age.
Intensive Care Unit: 24 hours for spouse or significant other. Immediate family members 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. and 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.
Intermediate Care Unit: This six-bed new unit is located on the third floor and provides care to patients who need constant monitoring, but not the critical services provided in the intensive care unit.
Maternity: Noon to 8 p.m. All visitors must be at least 16 years of age.
Behavioral Services: 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday. 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. weekends and holidays. All visitors must be at least 13 years old.

 Lunch: 11:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m.
 Dinner: 5 - 6:45 p.m.
